In terms of 'in the meantime' for the Primary School places, the Educational Authority (DCC) has confirmed that places coming forward before completion of the new school should be able to be filled at existing Primary Schools with some modification in the short term to their facilities.

There has been less assurances from the GP surgeries, however discussions are taking place to secure this.

The Plan is clear that housing development cannot go ahead without addressing the infrastructure deficiencies and there will be an agreed phasing schedule. The Savills Infrastructure Delivery document for the Land North East of Blandford may also give some indication.

I will however, pass your comments on to the group following the consultation period for them to discuss and consider when preparing the Submission Plan.
