Royal Mail can deliver to Households and to Businesses for a minimum fee of £500 for up to 7900 leaflets. Unfortunately RM deliver to postcode sectors, and boundaries do not coincide with electoral boundaries.

Health

Town Centre Regeneration

NO B+NP ACTION at this stage. Roger & Councillors to keep a watching brief.

3. Managing the plan going forward

The group agreed that a B+ Steering Group should continue after the plan is adopted, but the membership / remit of the group may change over time, moving into a monitoring / compliance testing mode. A new MoU will be required.

ACTION Roger / Linda / Malcolm / Carol to consider the current MoU and to agree a mechanism for updating?

The group agreed that developing a good working relationship with Dorset Council Planning Officers would be key to ensuring B+NP policies are fully considered in future planning decisions.

ACTION Sally to discuss how B+NP might best engage with DC Planning officers going forward, including possibilities for some form of joint training.

ACTION Roger to discuss with David Walsh on 6th March

ACTION Linda to talk to Gillingham re how they have engaged with Dorset Council

It was suggested that guidance would be required for Councillors on how they should interact with the B+NP when making planning decisions in the future.

ACTION Sally & Billy to draft guidance for Planning Committee(s) for steering group review

ACTION Sally to produce an update report for the Town Council Meetings in March and April and to update the BFTC Planning Committee remit for review at the BFTC annual meeting in May. Sally to forward the updates to Carol & Malcolm for information / onward briefing (if considered suitable to each council).

ACTION Sally to send out a DOODLE POLL for the next Steering Group Meeting (i.e. before referendum) for possible dates from Monday 16/3 onwards

ACTION Sally to find out from Ed Gerry the likely timescale (and what steps are involved) from a YES vote at Referendum to the plan coming into force.
